15 The proposed ordinance abolishes the prohibition of minors in public poolrooms or billiard
16 rooms. The ordinance currently prohibits minors in public poolrooms and billiard rooms and
17 punishes the minor, the establishment, and any employees for a violation with criminal or civil
18 penalties. The ordinance is outdated, no longer addresses a need in the City, and is not being
19 utilized by law enforcement.
