Dear Mayor Silberberg and Members of City Council:

At its October 18, 2017 meeting, the Transportation Commission voted to endorse the CMAQ and RSTP Project Funding Request for FY2024, for a total of \$4.5 million. We enthusiastically support funding for multi-modal transportation projects, which have many goals, including reducing air pollutants in nonattainment areas, such as the Washington region.

The City's request for FY2024 include funding for the West End Transitway Operations, the City's Transportation Demand Management Program (GoAlex), commuter outreach activities, bike share expansion and other bicycle and pedestrian infrastructure improvements. Furthermore, the funding request also include smart transportation solutions through Intelligent Transportation Systems (ITS), and technology enhancements for DASH bus fleet. The funding request is aligned with and supports the Alexandria Transportation Master Plan and the City's policy of promoting multi-modal transportation,
