In Text Amendment No. 2018-0001, the Planning Commission, having found that the public necessity, convenience, general welfare and good zoning practice so require, recommended approval to the City Council on February 6, 2018 of a text amendment to the Zoning Ordinance to adopt Text Amendment No. 2018-0001, which recommendation was
15 16	approved by the City Council at public hearing on February 24, 2018;
17 18	2. The City Council in adopting this ordinance expressly adopts, ratifies, affirms and concurs in the finding and action of the Planning Commission above stated;
19 20	3. All requirements of law precedent to the adoption of this ordinance have been

23 24	THE CITY COUNCIL OF ALEXANDRIA HEREBY ORDAINS:
25 26 27	Section 1. That Sections 4-1403, 4-1403.1, and 4-1404 of the Zoning Ordinance be, and the same hereby are, amended by deleting the language shown in strikethrough and inserting new language shown in underline, as follows:
28 29	4-1403 - Permitted uses.
30	In order to provide an active pedestrian-oriented retail environment along Mount Vernon
31 32	Avenue, especially along the sidewalk and pedestrian way, permitted uses in the NR zone are limited as follows.
33	(A) Permitted ground floor uses. The following uses are permitted on the ground floor of
34	buildings facing the sidewalk:
35	(1) Retail establishment;
36	(2) Personal service establishment, except banks, pawnshops, check cashing, payday
37	loan and title loan businesses;
38	(3) Banks, business and professional offices, medical laboratory or offices and
39	laundromats, provided:
40	(a) The business facade shall be no wider than 30 feet along the street;
41	(b) No more than two such uses or entrances shall adjoin each other;
42	(4) Restaurants, when located within a shopping center or hotel;

45 46	any one time and with a frontage of less than 30 feet along Mount Vernon Avenue;

2	<u>(8)</u>	Health and athletic club if located within a shopping center, hotel or office
3		complex;
4	(9)	Utilities, as permitted by section 7-1200.

22	Alexandria Zoning Ordinance.

24	Se	ection 4. That this ordinance shall become effective on the date and at the time of			
25	its final passage, and shall apply to all applications for land use, land development or subdivision				
26	approval provided for under the City of Alexandria Zoning Ordinance which may be filed after				
27	such date, and shall apply to all other facts and circumstances subject to the provisions of the				
28	City of Alexandria Zoning Ordinance, except as may be provided in Article XII of the Zoning				
29	Ordinance.
