9 AN ORDINANCE to amend and reordain Section 5-3-4 (VARIANCE OR WAIVER OF
10 PROVISIONS OF ARTICLE) of Chapter 3 (UNDERGROUND UTILITIES) of Title 5
11 (TRANSPORTATION AND ENVIRONMENTAL SERVICES) of the Code of the City of
12 Alexandria, Virginia, 1981, as amended.

14 Summary

15
16 Section 5-3-4 provides that the Director of Transportation and Environmental Services may
17 waive requirements pertaining to new or expanded overhead customer utility services and to
18 new or relocated overhead transmission and distribution facilities, provided that the Director
19 finds that the new, extended or relocated service or facility is required to provide additional
20 street lighting to suppress criminal activity and that the waiver is requested or supported by the
21 director of the office of citizens' assistance or the chief of police.

23 This technical amendment removes reference to approval from the Office of Citizens'
24 Assistance, which is a defunct department. This ordinance is part of the comprehensive effort to
25 update the City Code.
