### **Qualifications Statement – Tammy S.K. Doran**

Tammy Doran has been selected to serve as the new Chief of Animal Control. Ms. Doran was selected and promoted after an extensive search for candidates and interviews conducted by the Executive Director/CEO and final approval by Animal Welfare League of Alexandria (AWLA) Board Members.

Ms. Doran has over 10 years of animal control experience including two years as an Animal Control Officer for the Richland County, South Carolina; five years as an Animal Control Officer for the City of Richmond, Virginia; and most recently, three years as Sergeant of Animal Services for the City of Alexandria, Virginia.

Since March 2015, Ms. Doran has served as Sergeant of Animal Services for the Animal Welfare League of Alexandria (AWLA) where she has supervised Animal Control Officers in the day-to-day operations of Animal Control, including investigations and patrol.

Mr. Doran completed the National Animal Control Association (NACA) Training Academy resulting in several certifications including euthanasia training and certification. Ms. Doran is also an active member of the Virginia Animal Fighting Task Force that assists Virginia jurisdictions with investigations and seizures involving animal fighting and cruelty to animals.

Ms. Doran has significant experience in animal control, problem solving, investigations and supervision and will be responsible for the Animal Control Services provided by the Animal Welfare League of Alexandria (AWLA) through contract with the City of Alexandria.
