INFORMATION ON PROPOSED ORDINANCE

Title

AN ORDINANCE to amend and reordain Section 2-4-190 (CREATION, COMPOSITION AND ORGANIZATION) of Article X (ALEXANDRIA BEAUTIFICATION COMMISSION) of Chapter 4 (COMMITTEES, BOARDS, AND COMMISSIONS) of Title 2 (GENERAL GOVERNMENT) of the Code of the City of Alexandria, Virginia, 1981, as amended.

Summary

Section 2-4-190 contains the requirements for the composition of the Alexandria Beautification Commission. Currently, the statute allows all 16 members to be citizens-at-large. The Commission has requested an amendment to require some of the members to be representative of certain groups. The representation requirements pertain to substantive areas of expertise, such as architecture, landscape design, and gardening, and reserve 13 spots for citizens-at-large.

This Ordinance is part of the comprehensive effort to update the City Code.
