16	Virginia Code 17.1-279.1 was enacted in 2014 and provides localities with the authority to add
17	an electronic summons system fee of five dollars on any defendant convicted on any traffic or
18	criminal charge in the Alexandria General District Court or Alexandria Circuit Court. The

19	funds generated by the assessment must be used to solely to fund software, hardware, and
20	associated equipment costs for the implementation and maintenance of an electronic summons
21	system. Institution of an electronic summons system would significantly improve the
22	efficiency and accuracy in the process of issuing citations and allow for reduction of
23	voluminous paper documentation and the need to transfer such documentation between
24	multiple City agencies.
