That Section 3-1-5 of The Code of the City of Alexandria, Virginia, 1981, as amended, be, and the same hereby is amended and reordained to read as follows: 11 12 Sec. 3-1-5 - Alexandria Affordable Housing Initiatives Account. 13 14 Establishment of account. There is hereby established for the City of Alexandria a permanent account within the Alexandria Affordable Housing Fund to be known and designated as the 15 City of Alexandria Affordable Housing Initiatives Account, which account shall be accounted 16 for and maintained separate and apart from all other accounts maintained by the City of 17 18 Alexandria. Funding of account. 19 (b) 20 i. There is hereby assigned and appropriated to such Account, for the fiscal year commencing July 1, 2010 and in each succeeding fiscal year, from the tax on real estate levied pursuant to 21 section 3-2-181 of this code, in addition to all other appropriations made to such account, if 22 any, the sum of \$0.006 on each \$100 of the assessed value of all real estate subject to such 23 24 tax. 25 26 ii. There is hereby assigned and appropriated to such Account for the fiscal year 27 commencing July 1, 2018 and in each succeeding fiscal year, from the tax on meals sold by 28 restaurants levied pursuant to section 3-2-242 of this code, in addition to all other appropriations made to such account, if any, the sum of one percent of the tax on meals sold 29 30 by restaurants. 31 Expenditures from account. Notwithstanding any contrary provision of law, appropriations 32 from the said account shall be authorized and made exclusively to assist, finance and support, 33 34 directly or indirectly, the provision of housing which is affordable to households with incomes up to the limits established in the city's Affordable Housing Policy, as from time to time 35 amended. Unexpended appropriations to such account shall not lapse or expire at the end of 36 37 the fiscal year in which made, irrespective of whether such appropriations were encumbered within such fiscal year. 38 39 The provision of housing defined. As used in this section, the provision of housing includes, 40 without limitation, the preservation of existing housing; the construction of new housing, or 41 financial or other assistance for the purchase and/or rental of housing units, in accordance with 42 the city's Affordable Housing Policy, or with the city's Consolidated Plan for Housing and
