Key Features


- New building for restrooms and storage
- New concession building
- New scoreboard relocated to east side of site
- New press box relocated behind the visitor bleachers
- New athletic field lighting
- New sound system

Project Improvements

- New entry canopy over existing steps and ramp
- New ticket booth
- New plaza area and seating near concession building
- New track surface with additional 8th lane
- New field turf surface
- Improved pedestrian walkways and pedestrian lighting
- Improved stormwater management and new landscape plantings






Pole Assembly (Typical)


Option A:


- (2) 80 Foot Poles North(2) 70 Foot Poles South
- Compared to Option B, the overall light pattern is tighter and more precisely aimed. Glare impact is less along the west and south property lines.



Modifications Based on Community Input

- Moving buildings away from the western property boundary
- Complying with the setback and moving the scoreboard location to the opposite side of the site
- Addressing noise with a sound system study
- Pursuing SUP for greater height of light poles to better control light spillage and glare

Conditions



- Proposed Condition 131 would allow hours of lighting to end at 10:15 PM Monday – Saturday and 8:30 on Saturday and Sunday
- Events held Monday through Thursday restricted to ACPS interscholastic sports team games and practices
- Schedule of lighted events to be posted and mailed
- Limited sound system use
- Light & sound system testing & compliance monitoring
- T.C. Williams Neighborhood Forum
- Community Liaison
- Landscape and fence improvement plan

Staff Recommendation





- Staff recommends approval of the Development Special Use Permit with site plan
- Staff recommends
 approval of the Special
 Use Permit to permit
 athletic field lighting
 with (2) 80-foot light
 poles and (2) 70-foot
 light poles
- Subject to compliance with all applicable codes and conditions.
