1	ORDINANCE NO
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3	AN ORDINANCE authorizing the owners of the property located at 100 East Luray Avenue to
4	construct and maintain an encroachment into the public right-of-way at that location for a fence
5	and side yard access.
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7	WHEREAS, Katherine and Brian Bartholomay are the owners ("Owners") of the
8 9	property located at 100 East Luray Avenue in the City of Alexandria, Virginia; and
9 10	WHEREAS, Owners desire to construct and maintain a fence to provide increased
10	access to what visually reads as the side yard of the property, which will encroach into the public
12	right-of-way at that location, along the portion of the property, which will electoden into the public
12	inght of way at that ideation, along the portion of the property that borders ite with bucet, and
14	WHEREAS, the public right-of-way at that location will not be significantly
15	impaired by this encroachment; and
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17	WHEREAS, in Encroachment No. 2018-0011, the Planning Commission of the City
18	of Alexandria recommended approval to the City Council subject to certain conditions at one of
19	its regular meetings held on September 4, 2018, which recommendation was approved by the
20	City Council at its public hearing on September 15, 2018, and
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22	WHEREAS, it has been determined by the Council of the City of Alexandria that
23	this encroachment is not detrimental to the public interest; now, therefore,
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25	THE CITY COUNCIL OF ALEXANDRIA HEREBY ORDAINS:
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27	Section 1. That Owners be, and the same hereby are, authorized to establish and
28	maintain an encroachment into the public right-of-way at 100 East Luray Avenue in the City of
29 20	Alexandria, as shown on the attached encroachment plat, said encroachment measuring
30 31	approximately 879 square feet and located along Newton Street adjacent to the Owners' property, to construct a fence and provide access to a side yard, for a period of one year from the
32	date of this Ordinance, or until the encroachment is removed or destroyed or the authorization to
32 33	maintain it is terminated by the city, whichever is sooner; provided that this authorization to
33 34	establish and maintain the encroachment shall not be construed to relieve Owners of liability for
35	any negligence on their part on account of or in connection with the encroachment and shall be
36	subject to the provisions set forth below.
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38	Section 2. That the authorization hereby granted to establish and maintain said
39	encroachment shall be subject to and conditioned upon Owners maintaining, at all times and at
40	their own expense, general liability insurance in the amount of \$1,000,000 with a company
41	authorized to transact business in the Commonwealth of Virginia.
42	
43	This liability insurance policy shall identify the City of Alexandria and Owners as named
44	insureds and shall provide for the indemnification of the City of Alexandria and Owners against

any and all loss occasioned by the establishment, construction, placement, existence, use or 1 maintenance of the encroachment. Evidence of the policy and any renewal thereof shall be filed 2 with the city attorney's office. Any other provision herein to the contrary notwithstanding, in the 3 4 event this policy of insurance lapses, is canceled, is not renewed or otherwise ceases to be in force and effect, the authorization herein granted to establish and maintain the encroachment 5 shall, at the option of the city, forthwith and without notice or demand by the city, terminate. In 6 that event, Owners shall, upon notice from the city, remove the encroachment from the public 7 8 right-of-way, or the city, at its option, may remove the encroachment at the expense and risk of Owners. Nothing in this section shall relieve Owners of their obligations and undertakings 9 10 required under this ordinance. 11 Section 3. That the authorization hereby granted to establish and maintain said 12 encroachment shall in addition be subject to and conditioned upon the following terms: 13 14 a) Neither the City nor any Private utility company will be held responsible for damage to 15 the private improvements in the public right-of-way during repair, maintenance or 16 replacement of any utilities that may be located within the area of the proposed 17 encroachment. 18 19 20 b) In the event the City shall, in the future, have need for the area of the proposed encroachment, the Owners shall remove any structure that encroached into the public 21 right-of-way, within 60 days upon notification by the City, and the Owners shall bear all 22 costs of removal. 23 24 c) No fencing may be installed within one foot (1.0') of a city-owned paved surface. 25 26 d) The authorization granted herein to construct and maintain this encroachment shall expire 27 on November 17, 2019, and the encroachment shall terminate no later than that date. 28 29 Section 4. That by accepting the authorization hereby granted to establish and 30 maintain the encroachment and by so establishing and maintaining the encroachment, Owners 31 shall be deemed to have promised and agreed to save harmless the City of 32 Alexandria from any and all liability (including attorneys' fees and litigation expenses) arising by 33 reason of the establishment, construction, placement, existence, use or maintenance of the 34 encroachment. 35 36 Section 5. That the authorization herein granted to establish and maintain the 37 encroachment shall be subject to Owners maintaining the area of the encroachment at all times 38 unobstructed and free from accumulation of litter, snow, ice and other potentially dangerous 39 40 matter. Section 6. That nothing in this ordinance is intended to constitute, or shall be 41 deemed to be, a waiver of sovereign immunity by or on behalf of the City of Alexandria or any 42 of its officers or employees. 43 44

1	Section 7. That the authorization herein granted to establish and maintain the
2	encroachment shall be terminated whenever the City of Alexandria desires to use the affected
3	public right-of-way for any purpose whatsoever and, by written notification, demands from
4	Owners the removal of the encroachment. Said removal shall be completed by the date specified
5	in the notice and shall be accomplished by Owners without cost to the city. If Owners cannot be
6	found or shall fail or neglect to remove the encroachment within the time specified, the City shall
7	have the right to remove the encroachment, at the expense of Owners, and shall not be liable to
8	Owners for any loss or damage to the structure of the encroachment or personal property within
9	the encroachment area, caused by the removal.
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11	Section 8. That this ordinance shall be effective upon the date and at the time of its
12	final passage.
