11 CITATIONS) of Chapter 2 (TAXATION) of Title 3 (FINANCE, TAXATION AND
12 PROCUREMENT) of the Code of the City of Alexandria, Virginia, 1981, as amended.

14 Summary

16 The City Code provides the methods by which the registered owner of a motor vehicle, or
17 another authorized person, may contest a parking citation at Section 3-2-353. As currently
18 written, the owners of vehicles are being required to notarize their forms contesting the citation.
19 This ordinance will remove reference to an affidavit to remove the requirement that the form be
20 notarized.
