Recommendations




- Direct that a Vibrancy and Sustainability Plan be developed for the Art Center.
- Recognize that substantial capital funding of \$10 million to \$15 million will be required in the next decade.
- Affirm that the City of Alexandria Office of the Arts continue as the entity responsible for management and operations.

- Built in 1918 and acquired by the City in 1969
- Opened as an art center in 1974
- Home to 130
 resident artists in 82
 studios, 7 galleries,
 The Art League,
 City Archaeology

- City assumed operations in October, 2016
- 3-year leases (expire September 30, 2019) directly with artists
- Below market rates @ \$16 sq. ft
