Each applicant for a permit required by this article shall, in a writing made out in duplicate, file an application with the city manager requesting permission to hold a parade. Each application shall also state the name of the person or group holding the parade, the purpose, the number of participants, the number of vehicles and floats, the proposed route, the length of time the parade will take, and such other pertinent data as would assist the city in making plans to conduct the parade.
