







RMF Zone Purpose

- Zone established to provide land areas for multifamily residential development and to enhance or preserve long-term affordability of housing
- Implementation task highlighted in the South Patrick Street Housing Affordability Strategy
- Additional tool to achieve Housing Master Plan goals




Open Space and Height

Recommendation

On February 5, 2019, Planning Commission unanimously recommended approval with the following amendments:

- Additional text to section 3-1405(B)(3).
- Revised reference in Section 3-1407.
- Addition of the word "commercial," to describe "operations," in Section 3-1408(A).
- Revised language in Section 3-1408(E) to provide flexibility in the loading zone.
