INFORMATION ON PROPOSED ORDINANCE

Title

AN ORDINANCE to amend and reordain Article F (PERMIT PARKING DISTRICTS) of Chapter 8 (PARKING AND TRAFFIC REGULATIONS) of Title 5 (TRANSPORTATION AND ENVIRONMENTAL SERVICES) of the Code of the City of Alexandria, Virginia, 1981, as amended, by amending Section 5-8-82 (Restricted Overnight Parking Districts) and Section 5-8-83 (Restricted Daytime Parking District).

Summary

The proposed ordinance updates the City Code sections that establish the overnight and daytime parking districts to change the references that require a vehicle to display a City decal to instead require that vehicles are registered with the City of Alexandria pursuant to City Code Section 3-2-229. This change is necessary due to the recent elimination of city decals.
