9 AN ORDINANCE to amend and reordain Article F (PERMIT PARKING DISTRICTS) of

17 The proposed ordinance updates the City Code sections that establish the overnight and
18 daytime parking districts to change the references that require a vehicle to display a City decal
19 to instead require that vehicles are registered with the City of Alexandria pursuant to City Code
20 Section 3-2-229. This change is necessary due to the recent elimination of city decals.
