





- **Discussion & Guidance -EAP 2040**




Public Engagement

- Continuing online comments until April 27, 2019




Feedback from Engagement

- Actions for mitigation & adaptation/resiliency




Related City Efforts Under Development to be Integrated

- Green Building
 - Policy is being updated (June 2019). EAP actions will be incorporated.
- Land Use and Open Space
 - Open space study work to develop policies and actions to be incorporated into the EAP 2040
 - (June 2019) and (December 2019)
