






# Commute Day 1

#### **Morning Travel Times**


- Traffic patterns were typical on King Street westbound between the King Street Metrorail station and I-395.
- In Alexandria, travel times were between 20% and 30% higher than last week on Washington Street, Route 1 and North Van Dorn in the morning.
- Weather and a crash on the 14<sup>th</sup> Street Bridge contributed to traffic backups





#### **Metrorail Stations & Shuttles**

- The Van Dorn, King Street and Eisenhower Metrorail Stations had moderate wait times and little to no crowding.
- During the morning peak hour, Braddock Road experienced mid-level queuing with most passengers accommodated on the arriving shuttle.
  Bus bunching was an issue today with a longer than planned gap and then two shuttles arriving at the same time.





### By the Numbers

- 84 passengers used the Water Taxi during the AM commute period
- 140 parking permits issued at Landmark Mall
- WMATA added 9 additional buses to cover capacity
- 44 parking citations
- Approximately 2,200 riders on the Blue line during the morning commute
