### INFORMATION ON PROPOSED ORDINANCE

#### Title

ORDINANCE soliciting franchise proposals to use the Alexandria City Marina area to dock an historic or a replica historic tall ship consistent with the Waterfront Small Area Plan.

#### Summary

The proposed ordinance provides for the granting of a franchise for the docking and mooring of an historic or a replica historic tall ship for sightseeing tours, private charters, private events and educational programming and to allow, if necessary the design, construction, upgrade of City infrastructure in the City Marina (as defined by City Code section 6-3-2).
