

**RESOLUTION NO. 2889**

**WHEREAS**, the City Council recognizes the vital role of INOVA Alexandria Hospital and other Health System Partners in the community;

**WHEREAS**, the City Council re-established the City Council/INOVA Alexandria Task Force in Resolution Number 2119 dated October 12, 2004;

**WHEREAS**, City Council wishes to change the name of the City Council/INOVA Alexandria Task Force to the Alexandria Health System Partners;

**NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** by the City Council of Alexandria that the City Council/INOVA Alexandria Task Force shall hereby be named the Alexandria Health System Partners.

Alexandria Health System Partners shall consist of two representatives of the Alexandria City Council appointed by the Mayor, the City Manager or his designee, the President of INOVA Alexandria Hospital or his/her designee, the Director of the Alexandria Health Department, the Executive Director of the local Federally Qualified Health Center, the local Health Foundation and City Department Heads for Fire/EMS and Community and Human Services with support from other City and Hospital staff as required.

Alexandria Health System Partners will meet at least three times per year and will review financial, programmatic, and other matters that affect the City, the INOVA Alexandria Hospital and other Health System Partners in an effort to further enhance collaboration and communication that strengthens the Alexandria Health Safety Net.

This resolution shall be effective on the date and at the time of adoption.
