INFORMATION ON PROPOSED ORDINANCE

Title

AN ORDINANCE to amend and reordain Chapter 4 (STOPPING, STANDING, AND PARKING) of Title 10 (MOTOR VEHICLES AND TRAFFIC) of the Code of the City of Alexandria, Virginia, 1981, as amended, by amending Section 10-4-8 (PARKING FOR MORE THAN 72 CONTINUOUS HOURS).

Summary

The proposed ordinance updates the City Code to continue to allow the 72-hour rule exemption, which allows residents to apply to park on the street up to 14 days. The proposed ordinance increases the number of allowable exemptions per vehicle per year from four to five.
