NVTA's Six Year Program

- NVTA 70% funds are currently programmed through FY2023
- Current call for projects: FY 2024 to FY 2025
- 70% Regional Transportation Funding
- \$400 million available for two years for entire region (based on current revenue estimates)
- Generally for larger capital projects


Proposed Project




- Duke St Transitway (Corridor B)
 - \$75 million for FY 2024 to FY 2025
 - Phase 1:
 - Signalization, buses, stations, some road widening
 - Queue jump lanes, pedestrian and bicycle access
- City received \$12 million in FY18 to FY23 for environmental and design
- Planning to begin in 2020

- Total: \$102,141,152
- FY14
 - Potomac Yard Metrorail Station EIS \$2,000,000
 - Shelters & Real Time Transit for DASH/WMATA \$450,000
 - Traffic Signal Upgrades/Transit Signal Priority \$660,000
 - DASH Bus Expansion \$1,462,500
- FY15/16
 - Potomac Yard Metrorail Station Planning, PE, Design \$1,500,000
 - Duke Street Transit Signal Priority \$190,000
 - West End Transitway Design, Construction \$2,400,000
- FY17
 - Potomac Yard Metro Design, PE, Construction \$66,000,000
- FY18 to FY23
 - Alexandria Duke Street Transitway \$12,000,000
 - Alexandria ITS Projects \$1,195,491
 - Alexandria Bus Network ITS \$150,000
 - West End Transitway \$2,200,000
 - DASH Transit Service Enhancements \$11,933,161
