# Proposed sale of four Cityowned parcels

- Section 9.06 of the City's Charter requires that the Planning Commission review any acquisition or sale of public land.
- Planning Commission is charged with ensuring that any such acquisition, sale or change is consistent with the City's Master Plan.

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- 2007 Mayor's Economic Sustainability Work Group
- 2008 City Property Inventory
- 2009 Council approved four sites surplus for immediate disposition
- 2016 Unsolicited offer from Galena Capital Partners for sale of subject parcels
- 2016 Council issued RFP

### Galena Proposal

### 116 S. Henry Street

- Automated parking garage (148 spaces)
- Two retail spaces (3500 sf)
- 22 residential units

### 912-920 King Street

- Retail space (6700 sf)
- Up to 30 residential units
- Pocket park/urban greenery
