2 3	AN ORDINANCE to amend and reordain Section 12-6-2 (COMPOSITION; APPOINTMENT,
4	TERMS AND COMPENSATION OF MEMBERS; FILLING VACANCIES; CHAIRPERSON
5	AND VICE CHAIRPERSON), and Section 12-6-3 (MEETINGSQUORUM; RULES OF
6	PROCEDURE; ANNUAL REPORT TO COUNCIL) of Chapter 6 (COMMISSION FOR
7	WOMEN), Title 12 (EDUCATION, SOCIAL SERVICES AND WELFARE) of The Code of the
8 9	City of Alexandria, Virginia, 1981, as amended.
10	THE CITY COUNCIL OF ALEXANDRIA HEREBY ORDAINS:
11	
12	Section 1. That section 12-6-2 of The Code of the City of Alexandria, Virginia,
13	1981, as amended, be, and the same is hereby, amended and reordained as follows:
14 15	Sec. 12-6-2 Composition; appointment, terms and compensation of members; filling vacancies;
16	chairperson and vice chairperson.
17	
18	The commission shall consist of 15 16 members appointed at large by the city council, one
19	of which shall be a youth member, between the ages of 16 and 24. Members shall be
20 21	appointed for terms of three years each which shall expire as of May 31. Any vacancy shall be filled by the council for the unexpired portion of a term. A chairperson and a vice chairperson
22	shall be chosen by a majority vote of all the members of the commission. Members shall serve
23	without compensation but may receive such reimbursement for expenses as the council may
24	from time to time allow.
25	
26	Section 2. That section 12-6-3 of The Code of the City of Alexandria, Virginia,
27 28	1981, as amended, be, and the same is hereby, amended and reordained reads as follows:
29	Sec. 12-6-3 Meetings-quorum; rules of procedure; annual report to council.
30	
31	The commission shall meet at least once each month from September to June, and may meet
32	in July and August. All meetings shall be open to the public. All members of the commission
33 34	shall be entitled to vote, <b>including the youth member</b> , and the decisions of the commission shall be determined by a majority vote of the members present. A quorum of eight members
34 35	present is required before the commission can take official action. A member present but not
36	voting shall be considered in counting a quorum. In matters concerning the procedure for
37	meetings not covered by this chapter, the commission may establish its own rules, provided these
38	are not contrary to the mandate or spirit of this chapter. The commission shall render each year
39	by June 30, to the city council a written report of its activities under the provisions of this chapter
40 41	along with any comments and recommendations as it may choose to make.
42	Section 3. Notwithstanding any contrary provision of law establishing the existing
43	terms of their appointment, the terms of the members of the Commission for Women serving on
44	May 31, 2001, shall be determined by drawing lots as follows: five members shall serve until
45	May 31, 2002, five members shall serve until May 31, 2003, and five members shall serve until
46 47	May 31, 2004.
48	Section 4. That this ordinance shall become effective upon the date and at the time
49	of its final passage.
