The purpose of this amendment is to better address current residential 17 parking issues, improve the City's ability to proactively manage parking, and make 18 19 understanding, enforcing and administering the standards more straightforward for citizens and staff. A brief overview of the changes is provided below: 20 21 22 Posted parking restrictions (City Code 5-8-72(b)(1)) – This section has been updated to limit residential permit parking end time options on most blocks to either 5:00 PM or 11:00 PM, 23 while allowing a 2:00 AM end time on blocks where it is deemed appropriate by the Director 24 25 of Transportation and Environmental Services. 26 27 Process for creation of new residential permit parking districts (City Code 5-8-73(b)) – This section has been updated to add a process for creating new residential permit parking 28 29 districts near transit or in areas with documented parking issues. 30 31 Removal of occupancy survey requirement for residential permit parking signage **changes** (City Code 5-8-75) – This section has been updated by removing the occupancy 32 survey requirement for residential permit parking signage to be posted on blocks already within 33 a residential permit parking district and maintains the petition requirement to initiate the 34 35 request. 36 37 **Administrative changes** – This section has been updated to make administrative changes 38 including changes that: 39 i) amend language clarifying parties that are eligible to sign petitions pertaining to residential permit parking (City Code 5-8-75(b)-(c), 5-8-76(b)-(c), 5-8-82(c)(4), 5-8-40 41 83(c)(1), and 5-8-84(b)(4); allow the Traffic and Parking Board to approve the expansion of a residential permit 42 ii) parking district rather than City Council (City Code 5-8-74(a)); 43 allow the Director of Transportation and Environmental Services to designate blocks 44 iii) 45 which abut two districts with parking restrictions as areas where holders of either abutting district permits are exempt from the parking restrictions (City Code 5-8-73(f)); 46 47 iv) require the same residential permit parking restrictions on both sides of a block, where residential permit parking restrictions exist on both sides by updating several 48 references throughout the Article from "block face" to "block;" and 49
