18 19	(a) Every dealer shall keep at his place of business for at least 24 months, or carry with him		
20	while conducting business, a record permanently bound book in which shall be legibly		
21	recorded with ink in the English language, at the time of the purchase or pawn of any		
22	item aforesaid within the city in the course of his business, an accurate account of each		
23	such transaction. The record shall set forth an accurate and legible description of the		
24	goods, articles or things purchased or pawned, the name, residence and description of		
25 26	the person selling or pawning the same, the driver's license number or social security		
26 27	number of the seller or pawner, <u>a transaction or invoice number</u> and the dealer's permit number. The description of the person required by this section shall consist of the hair		
28	color, sex, race, approximate height, weight, date of birth and any distinguishing		
29	features of such person. In order to ensure the accuracy of the information, the dealer		
30	shall comply with the provisions of section 9-8-19(d). Such record book shall during		
31	regular business hours be open to the inspection of the director. It shall be unlawful for		
32	any person to fail to exhibit to the director any record book required to be kept pursuant		
33	to this section.		
34 35	(b) Each dealer shall also keep and maintain for at least 24 months on accurate and leasible		
33 36	(b) Each dealer shall also keep and maintain for at least 24 months an accurate and legible record of the name and address of the person, form or corporation to which he sells any		
30 37	item aforesaid after the waiting period required by section 9-8-18. This record shall also		
38	show the name and address of the seller from whom the dealer purchased such item.

40	(c) Anything in this section to the contrary notwithstanding, a junk dealer shall not be		
41	required to record transactions pertaining to the purchase of rags, bones, old iron, paper		
42	and aluminum cans; further, there shall be excluded from this section any transaction by

15	provide deliver or mail to the Chief of Police within 24 hours of the time of purchase, in a			
16	manner on blank dorms to be prescribed by the chief of police or on a copy of the bill of sale, a			
17	legible and accurate description of every article or thing required to be entered in a record book			
18	provided for under the preceding section. The record of transaction form or bill of sale shall set			
19	forth the dealer's permit number, the driver's license number or social security number of the			
20	seller or pawner, together with a description of the person selling the same including the hair			
21	color, sex, race, approximate height, weight, date of birth and any distinguishing features,			
22	together with a reference to the transaction or invoice number volume and page number of the			
23	record book where the	ne original entry required by the preceding section was made.

26	ordinance, be, and the same hereby is, reordained as part of the City of Alexandria City Code.
