

COMMEMORATING THE FIFTH ANNIVERSARY OF THE FREE HEALTH FAIR FOR ALEXANDRIA'S UNINSURED

Since its first year in 2015, The Free Health Fair has brought "Health and Hope" to more than 1,000 low-income uninsured residents of the City of Alexandria!!

More than 1,000 adults and children have received a broad-array of diagnostic and preventive health services, including vision and hearing screenings, glucose tests for diabetes, dental screenings and referrals, blood pressure monitoring, mental health screenings, and HIV tests and counseling.

Hundreds have been referred to Neighborhood Health for critical follow-up care, where, as a result, many are now enrolled as their "medical home".

Many others were assisted with applying for Obamacare, Medicaid, and FAMIS.

Still others continue to benefit from the free or discounted health and/or social services offered by the numerous community-based organizations that have exhibited at the Fairs.

The value of the Free Health Fair was summed up best by a Spanish-speaking attendee at the Second Health Fair:

"Thanks and blessings to all the generous people who helped to make this program a reality.

The Hispanic community is grateful."
