INFORMATION ON PROPOSED ORDINANCE

Title

An Ordinance to amend and reordain subsection (l) (Agudas Achim Congregation Election District) of Section 2-2-10 (Establishment of Election Districts and Voting Places), and to amend and reordain “The Official Map of the City of Alexandria, Virginia, Designating Election Districts and Voting Places,” adopted by Section 2-2-13 (Map of Election Districts and Polling Places), all of Chapter 2 (Elections), Title 2 (General Government) of The Code of the City of Alexandria, Virginia, 1981, as amended to rename the Agudas Achim Congregation Election District the Charles Barrett Center Election District and establish the Charles Barrett Center (in lieu of Agudas Achim Synagogue) as the polling place for this precinct for elections in 2020 and thereafter.

Summary

The proposed ordinance changes the name, but not the boundaries, of the Agudas Achim Congregation Election District to the Charles Barrett Center Election District and changes the voting location from Agudas Achim Congregation located at 2908 Valley Drive to the Charles Barrett Center located at 1115 Martha Custis Drive.
