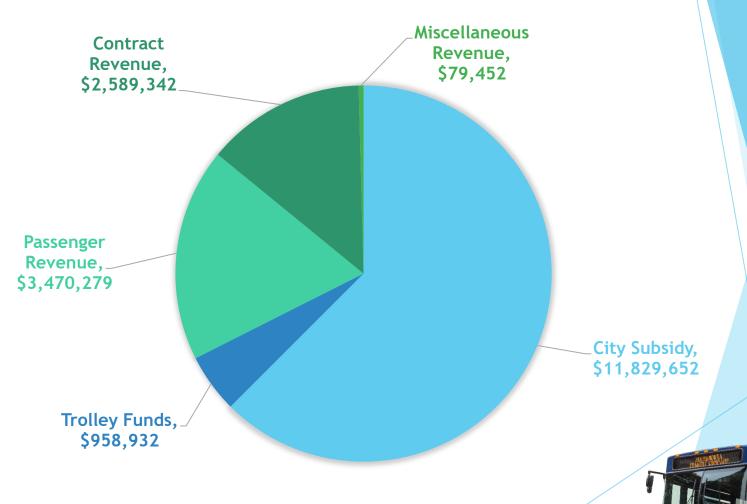

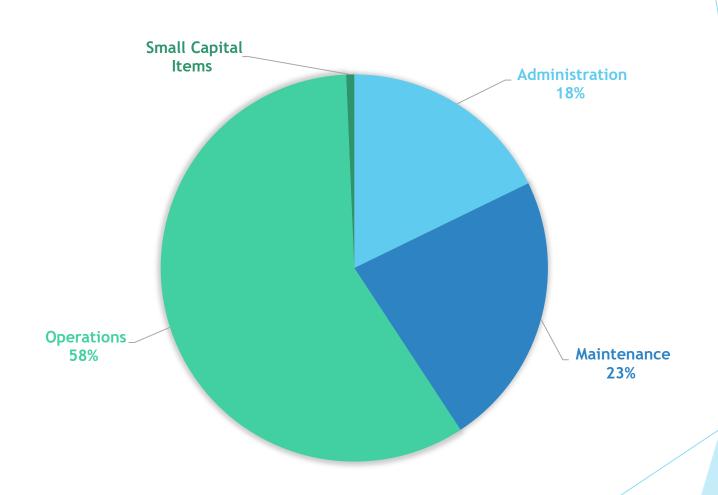


Funding Mechanisms (Based on Fiscal Year 2019)

- Celebrated 35 Years of Service to the Alexandria Community
- Ratified a new Labor Agreement bringing salaries to regional parity
- DASH Bus Mobile Ticketing Pilot
 - First transit system in the region to offer mobile ticketing smartphone application
 - Use grew from 1,000 in June to over 5,000 by October
- Alexandria Transit Vision Plan (Update will be provided during future Council Meeting)





- I-395 Commuter Choice Service Improvements
 - Awarded ~\$5 Million in new funds over 20 months to implement major service improvements including the AT-1 PLUS and AT-9
 - *AT-1 PLUS Ridership
 - 26% increase in November
 - 32% increase in December
 - *AT9 Ridership
 - 42% increase in November
 - 51% increase in December





- Awarded Funds to purchase Six (6) Battery Electric
 Buses, anticipated as the first in Virginia
- Implemented Real Time Bus Arrival Displays at 30 of the highest ridership stops in the City
- Invested in 13 replacement Buses helping to bring the fleet back to a state of good repair





- WMATA Platform Improvement Project (PIP)
 - Contracted to operate the Blue Line Shuttle (May 2019-August 2019)
 - Unprecedented growth and mobilization in a matter of Months, largest expansion and largest operation in the history of the Company
 - Workforce Expansion from 200 to over 330
 - Fleet Expansion from 85 to over 130 Buses
 - Carried approximately 500,000 passengers
 - Universally regarded as the most successful and reliable mitigation strategies of the project
