


Telecommunications and Wireless Facilities

City Council Public Hearing February 22, 2020

Background and Purpose

- In 2018, the General Assembly adopted new standards governing local zoning review of wireless facilities.
- New standards enacted review deadlines, maximum fees, and restrictions on reasons for denial.





Small Cell Facilities (Existing and New)





- Regulations were codified within the zoning ordinance in 2017.
- Proposed text amendment would shorten the maximum review time to 60 days.

Standard Cell Facilities on Existing Structures



- Maximum filing fee of \$500.
- Zoning Review shall be completed within 60 days.
- Review shall be done administratively.

Standard Facilities on New Structures



- Includes monopoles and other facilities on standalone mounts.
- Special Use Permit required for facilities greater than 50 feet.
- Maximum 150-day review.






Eligible Facilities Request



- For changes to equipment on existing towers, mounts, and stations.
- Lowers the maximum fee:
 - \$500: standard cells
 - \$100: first 5 small cells.
 - \$50: any subsequent small cells.



Aesthetic Guidelines



- Codification of design standards regarding the design, color, and materials of wireless facilities.
- Allowed to adopt screening and landscaping guidelines.
- May be amended administratively.



Recommendation

On February 4, by a vote of 5-0 the Planning Commission recommends approval.
