

I. REPORT SUMMARY

The applicant, PS Southeast One, Inc. requests approval to name two new streets. Staff recommends approval of the Street Name request.

SITE DESCRIPTION

The new streets would be located within the subject property which is one irregularly shaped lot of record located to the south of South Pickett Street and to the east of Burnside Place.

A mix of industrial and commercial uses surround the subject site. Industrial businesses, including Alexandria Waste Recovery and Allied Van Lines, are located to the west towards Fairfax County. Retail shops, including Habitat for Humanity Restore and Alexandria Carpet One Floor and Home, are located to the north. The Aslin Brewing Company is located to the northeast of the site. The proposed streets would frame a future public storage facility development

BACKGROUND

City Council approved DSUP #2018-0006 on March 16, 2019, for the development of the Public Storage/BoatUS site located at 880 and 890 South Pickett Street and 620 Burnside Place. The project will be developed over two phases. Phase One will include the construction of the public storage site, landscape improvements and a public park. Phase Two will include the construction of a multi-family dwelling. Three streets will be constructed over the two phases as part of the development approval. One private street and one public alley will be created in Phase One and one public street will be created in Phase Two.

PROPOSAL




Figure 1 – Proposed new streets to be constructed during Phase One

The applicant, PS Southeast One, Inc., requests approval to name one new public alley and one new private street at the Public Storage/BoatUS development site during the project's Phase One stage. The public alley would be named Willow Alley and the private street would be named Azalea Avenue. Azalea Avenue would run parallel to South Pickett Street, connecting Burnside Place and Willow Alley, and provide access to a temporary parking lot. Willow Alley would run perpendicular to South Pickett Street (Figure 1).

CODE OF ORDINANCES

New street names are regulated in Section 5-2-64 in the Code of Ordinances. This section of the City Code identifies two specific points that dictate the naming convention of the proposed streets:

- 1. Section 5-2-64(a) states that new streets that run "in a generally eastward direction" shall be designated as avenues.
- 2. Section 5-2-64(a)(2) states that streets located to the west of Quaker Lane shall follow a general alphabetical progression.

There are no specific naming conventions for alleys in the City Code of Ordinances.

II. STAFF ANALYSIS

Staff supports the applicant's request to name two new streets at the Public Storage/BoatUS development site. The proposed street names Azalea Avenue and Willow Alley would comply with the City Code requirements for new street names. Staff analysis has also indicated that the proposed names would not conflict with other street names in the City of Alexandria or neighboring jurisdictions, ensuring that emergency services and the United States Postal Service will be able to easily locate the site.
