FY 2021 Budget Timeline

- City Manager presented proposed budget February 18
- Budget Public Hearing March 9
- City Council set the Maximum Tax Rate March 10
- City Council held 6 planned work sessions:
 - Revenues
 - Capital Improvement Program (CIP)
 - Alexandria City Public Schools (ACPS)
 - Employee Compensation
 - Healthy & Thriving Residents
 - Livable, Green and Prospering City



FY 2021 Budget Timeline

- Budget Update April 1
- City Manager presented revised budget version 2.0 – April 7
- No Add/Delete proposals
- Public hearing on revised budget –
 April 18
- City Council to adopt the budget FY 2021 budget – April 29



FY 2021 Revised Budget 2.0

- \$753.3 M General Fund expenditures
 - \$46.7 M less than proposed (-5.8%)
- \$745.3 M General Fund revenue
 - \$54.6 M less than proposed (-6.8%)
- \$7.9 M planned use of fund balance (1.0% of proposed budget)
- No tax rate or stormwater utility fee increases



FY 2021 Revised Budget 2.0

- \$22.4 M cash capital reduction
- \$16.4 net reduction in City programs and services
- \$7.4 M ACPS transfer reduction
- \$0.4 M DASH transfer reduction
- \$2.0 M federal assistance



Budget Adoption

 Adoption is scheduled for tomorrow, April 29 at 7pm

- Three actions required:
 - Adopt Budget Resolution
 - Adopt Property Tax Rate Ordinance
 - Adopt Fee Increases (roll-call consent)
