14	Section 1. That Section 2-2-11 of The Code of the City of Alexandria, Virginia, 1981, as
15	amended, be, and the same hereby is, amended and reordained to delete the text shown in
16	strikethrough and add the text shown in underline as follows:
17	There is hereby established for the Oiter of Aleren driver and Oratual Alexander Mater
18	There is hereby established for the City of Alexandria one Central Absentee Voter
19 20	Election District, to be used for all elections. The voting place of the Central Absentee Voter
20	Election District shall be located at 132 North Royal Street, Alexandria, Virginia. The Central
21 22	Absentee Voter Election District shall conform in all respects with the provisions of Section 24.2-712 of the Code of Virginia (1950), as amended.

32	Absentee Voter Election District, to be used for the November elections. The voting place for the

34	Beatley, Jr. Central Library, 5005 Duke Street Alexandria, VA 22304. The Alexandria Electoral
35	Board is hereby authorized to determine the number of days that this additional permanent
36	Central Absentee Voter District shall be based upon anticipated need and voter turnout for each
37	November election. The days and hour of operation of this additional permanent Central
38	Absentee Voter District shall be advertised and posted consistent with all other advertising and
39	posting of the days and hours of operation of the Office of the Voter Registration and Elections
40	and all other Voter Election Districts. The additional Central Absentee Voter Election District
41	shall conform in all respects with the provisions of Section 24.2-712 of the Code of Virginia
42	(1950), as amended.
43	
44	There is hereby established for the City of Alexandria permanent Satellite Absentee
45	Voter Election Districts, to be used for the November Presidential elections. The voting places
46	for the Satellite Absentee Voter Election Districts shall be located at the Minnie Howard

1	Campus, 3801 W Braddock Rd, Alexandria, VA 22302, and George Washington Middle School,
2	1005 Mt Vernon Ave, Alexandria, VA 22301. The Alexandria Electoral Board is hereby
3	authorized to determine the number of days that these Satellite Absentee Voter Districts shall be
4	based upon anticipated need and voter turnout for each November Presidential election. The days
5	and hour of operation of these Satellite Absentee Voter Districts shall be advertised and posted
6	consistent with all other advertising and posting of the days and hours of operation of the Office
7	of the Voter Registration and Elections and all other Voter Election Districts. The Satellite
8	Absentee Voter Election Districts shall conform in all respects with the provisions of Section
9	24.2-701.1 of the Code of Virginia (1950), as amended.

11	Section 2. That Section 2-2-10 Subsection (n) of The Code of the City of Alexandria,
12	Virginia, 1981, as amended, be, and the same hereby is, amended and reordained to delete the
13	text shown in strikethrough and add the text shown in underline as follows:

15	(n) The Douglas MacArthur School Election District shall be bounded and described by
16	the census blocks shown on the map adopted by section 2-2-13 of this Code as comprising the
17	said district.
18	
19	The voting place within the Douglas MacArthur School Election District shall be at the
20	Douglas MacArthur School, located at 1101 Janney's Lane. <u>However, notwithstanding the prior</u> ,
21	for the November 2020 through November 2023 elections the voting place within the Douglas
22	MacArthur School Election District shall be at the George Washington Masonic National
23	Memorial, 101 Callahan Dr, Alexandria, VA 22301.
24	
25	Section 3. That "The Official Map of the City of Alexandria, Virginia, Designating
26	Election Districts and Voting Places," adopted by Section 2-2-13 of the Code of the City of
27	Alexandria, Virginia, 1981, as amended, be, and the same hereby is, amended and reordained as
28	shown on Exhibit 1, attached hereto and incorporated fully by reference, to reflect the temporary
29	voting place within the Douglas MacArthur School Election District at the George Washington
30	Masonic National Memorial, 101 Callahan Dr, Alexandria VA 22301.
31	Masome Matoha Memoria, 101 Cananan Di, Mexandria VII 22501.
32	Section 4. That the general registrar of voters be, and he hereby is, directed to record the
33	foregoing amendments on the said map.
34	Toregoing unrenaments on the sure map.
35	Section 5. That this ordinance shall become effective upon the date and at the time
36	of its final passage and the adjustments contained herein will be utilized for the elections in 2020
37	and thereafter until or unless further modified and amended.
