- Most questions are standard to allow for comparability with other jurisdictions
- The survey covers most front facing City services

Jan-Feb 2020*

Sent the survey to residents

- Households randomly selected
- Mail or online anonymous response
- 4 mailings

Feb-May 2020

Analyzed the Results

- Weighted responses to match city's demographics
- Compared to last vear and other jurisdictions (national, local, similar size/metro)

 - Note: custom questions do not have comparison to other jurisdictions














Highest, lowest or notable items

Openness and acceptance of the community towards people of diverse backgrounds








Vote in local elections






