For the past years of employment I was Senior Vice President for Research at Windwalker Corporation where I was employed from 2006 until my retirement. While at Windwalker, under a \$3.5 million contract with Housing and Urban Development (HUD), I directed the creation of a national game-based program to train personnel at HUD's 3,600 public housing authorities, including Alexandria's, to switch from a cash- to an asset-based business model. The HUD Asset Management curriculum includes 16 game-based courses covering five content modules: Introduction to Asset Management, Project-Based Funding, Project-Based Budgeting, Project-Based Accounting, Project-Based Management, and Project-Based Performance Assessment. This continues to be the largest non-military rollout of a federal initiative using online game-based training. Also at Windwalker, I led initial design efforts for the National Center for Educational Statistics' (NCES) proposed Institute for Large-Scale Assessment, managed staff training at 12 research centers nationwide for the Trends in Mathematics and Science Study, and managed the development and delivery of online tutorials to prepare Virginia educators to implement Virginia's Standards of Learning assessment.

Statement of Interest/Why You Should Be Appointed

I am interested in continuing my service as a citizen member of the Planning Commission to address planning issues that affect the City of Alexandria. Over the past 8 years, I have served on several ad hoc groups that addressed pressing planning issues in the city. This included the Parking Standards for New Development Projects Task Force, which recommended new standards that modernized the city's multifamily residential and commercial parking requirements; the Old Town Area Parking Study Work Group, which recommended new policies to better manage on-street parking along the King Street corridor; and the Ad Hoc Group for Digital Signs and A-Frame Portable Signs, which shepherded new guidelines for signage in the city. I have also supported small area planning efforts, including the Eisenhower East Small Area Plan, which was adopted by City Council in March 2020. In March 2019 I was elected Chair of the Planning Commission, a recognition by my fellow commissioners of the leadership role I serve. Our planning challenge as a City is ensuring a high quality-of-life while making the most of development opportunities. 
