Title

AN ORDINANCE to amend Chapter 12 (TAXICABS AND OTHER VEHICLES FOR HIRE) of Title 9 (LICENSING AND REGULATION) of the Code of the City of Alexandria, Virginia, 1981, as amended.

Summary

This ordinance would amend the City Code to improve the efficiency of taxi regulation, eliminate outdated taxi requirements, and add a requirement for taxicabs to carry uninsured and underinsured motorist insurance.
