

ORDINANCE NO. ____

AN ORDINANCE making appropriations for the support of the government of the City of Alexandria, Virginia, for Fiscal Year 2022.

THE CITY COUNCIL OF ALEXANDRIA HEREBY ORDAINS:

Section 1. That, pursuant to Section 6.07 of the City Charter, the sum of \$1,651,305,848 be, and the same hereby is, appropriated for the support of the government of the City of Alexandria in the fiscal year beginning on the first day of July 2021 and ending on the thirtieth day of June 2022.

Section 2. That, pursuant to Section 6.07 of the City Charter, the sum of \$1,651,305,848 appropriated in Section 1 of this ordinance for the support of the government of the City of Alexandria in the fiscal year beginning on the first day of July 2021 and ending on the thirtieth day of June 2022 be, and the same hereby is, further appropriated to the following City departments, major operating units, component units, and major categories of expenditures in the amounts set forth below:

Section 5. That, pursuant to Section 6.14 of the City Charter, the sum of \$293,102,842 be, and the same hereby is, appropriated for Capital Improvement Project expenditures of the City of Alexandria and the Alexandria City Public Schools in the fiscal year beginning on the first day of July 2021 and ending on the thirtieth day of June 2022. This sum, which consists of the \$ 293,102,842 appropriated as Capital Projects in Section 3 of this ordinance, is appropriated as follows: (i) \$ 237,903,642 capital projects that are included in the City government Fiscal Year 2022 - 2031 Capital Improvement Program adopted by City Council on May 5; and (ii) \$55,199,200 to the capital projects identified in the Alexandria City Public Schools' capital budget.

Section 6. That the sum of \$ 293,102,842 appropriated in Section 5 of this ordinance for capital improvement project expenditures of the City of Alexandria and the Alexandria City Public Schools in the fiscal year beginning on the first day of July 2021 and ending on the thirtieth day of June 2022 is expected to be derived from the following sources of revenue:

30 **Section 8.** That the sum of \$ 1,651,305,848 appropriated in Section 1 of this ordinance
31 for the support of the government of the City of Alexandria in the fiscal year beginning on the
32 first day of July 2021 and ending on the thirtieth day of June 2022 is, for accounting purposes
33 and in accordance with generally accepted accounting principles, attributed, for each City
34 department, major operating unit, component unit, and major category of expenditure, to the
35 funds maintained by the City as shown in Table I on the pages following this ordinance.

37 **Section 9.** That the sum of \$ 1,651,305,848 appropriated in Section 1 of this ordinance
38 for the support of the government of the City of Alexandria in the fiscal year beginning on the
39 first day of July 2021 and ending on the thirtieth day of June 2022 is, for accounting purposes
40 and in accordance with generally accepted accounting principles, attributed, for each major
41 source of revenue, to the funds maintained by the City as shown in Table II on the pages
42 following this ordinance.

44 **Section 10.** That the City Council of the City of Alexandria, Virginia does hereby make
45 provision for and appropriation to the funds hereafter named in the amounts required to defray
46 the expenditures and liabilities of the City for which commitments were established in the form

of encumbrances or otherwise on or before June 30, 2021 but which are payable in fiscal year 2022 and for which amounts were appropriated but not expended in fiscal year 2021 and further, that the City Council does hereby allot the amounts so appropriated to the several City departments for fiscal year 2022 as follows:
