Fiscal Year 2020-2021 Report of City Council Closed Meetings Alexandria City Council

Resolution 2707, adopted by City Council on January 2016, states: 1. Section 2.2-2711 of the Code of Virginia provides the specific legal rationale that the City Council must cite to go into executive session. Shortly after the conclusion of each fiscal year, the City Clerk is requested to publish on the City's website a report of all executive session activity in the previous fiscal year.

This report shall detail the number of executive sessions, the legal rationale for each executive session, and the Council votes to initiate and certify each executive session. This report shall also be docketed each year for Council review at the first legislative meeting in September.

City Council held 8 closed meeting in Fiscal Year 2020-2021.

Attached are the minutes from each of the 8 meetings detailing the legal rationale for each closed executive session and the Council votes to initiate and certify each closed executive session. The votes to go into all closed executive session were all in the majority.

The report is docketed for City Council review on September 14, 2021.
