# UpCycle's Accomplishments from the Past Year

## Supporting Equity, Inclusion and Access for the Arts

UpCycle provided local schools, nonprofits and Virtual+ partner programs with materials so that children had access to artistic and enrichment supplies while learning from home during the pandemic. Once students returned to schools, many teachers sourced individual sets of supplies from UpCycle so that students could safely create at school.

#### Collaborating with Local Organizations

UpCycle teamed up with ACT for Alexandria and Volunteer Alexandria to create and distribute 500 mask-making kits using materials from its reuse center. UpCycle also partnered with Art on the Avenue, SOHO and Volunteer Alexandria to provide more than 1,000 art kits so that children could create while staying safe at home.

### Facilitating Artistic Expression

UpCycle engaged the community through social media art challenges, as well as by hosting a Reuse Flower Garden exhibit outside the Durant Arts Center. UpCycle also safely operated its reuse center, which is full of materials that supplied artists and crafters who worked creatively at home. When it was safe to do so, UpCycle resumed some in-person programming.
