40 If approved, there will be some costs associated with implementing short term
41 improvements to the block to create a more permanent looking design for the street closure,
42 including removal of traffic signage and meters, installation of new barricades, and
43 improvements to seating areas and signage. Staff anticipates using ARPA funding that has
44 been allocated to this project to pay for these improvements. A longer-term redesign for the
45 block may be considered as part of the CIP budget process.
