The Del Ray Business Association is proud to recommend that one of the entrances to the heart of the Del Ray Business District be named after Nancy Dunning.

**DISCUSSION:** In response to the proposal from the Del Ray Business Association (Attachment 1), the Department of Recreation, Parks and Cultural Activities (RPCA) solicited public comment on the proposed park renaming from October 31, 2014 through November 28, 2014 (Attachment 2).

Community members received notifications of the public comment period by City eNews, neighborhood canvassing of the eNews release, the RPCA website, and through “word of mouth” assistance from the Del Ray Business Association.

On April 13, 2015, the City Council Naming Committee (Councilwoman Del Pepper, Chair; Mayor William Euille; and Lance Mallamo, Director, Office of Historic Alexandria) held a meeting with representatives of the Del Ray Citizens Association to discuss the naming proposal. The City Council Naming Committee voted unanimously to recommend to City Council that the park parcel at 2802 Mt. Vernon Ave the Nancy Dunning Garden.
