



month, which were last increased in FY 2020. The fee increases would continue to align the rates more closely with the market for parking and to be consistent with City policy that employers should charge the full cost for parking.

**FISCAL IMPACT:** Increasing the employee parking rates in FY 2021 is projected to generate approximately \$22,000 in additional General Fund revenue each year.
