



stations an EMS vehicle for response within the locality, or is a Designated Emergency Response Agency to adopt a resolution approving the request. The attached drafted resolution, if approved by Council, will allow the State to complete the licensure process. According to Len Mascaro, EMS Program Representative for Northern Virginia, the company meets all other requirements of the State. The City last approved a similar resolution for All American Ambulance & Transport on June 21, 2012. This private company will not compete with the Alexandria Fire Department's mission or respond to medical emergencies within the City.
