

charge \$5 for an On-Street Reserved Motorcoach Parking Permit Fee. Currently, this permit is free. The fee will help defray the costs of administering the system and provide a modest incentive for operators to use their permits efficiently.

The City currently offers several locations for Motorcoach parking, each with varying costs and time lengths.

1. Free, unreserved (first-come, first-served) parking:
 - a. 400 Block of Swann Ave (7 spaces)
2. Free, reserved short-term (4-hour) permit parking
 - a. 500 block of North Union Street (5 spaces)
 - b. 900 block of North St. Asaph Street (3 spaces)
3. Paid, reserved long-term parking, with daily and overnight rates (\$20 & \$45)
 - a. George Washington Masonic Temple, 101 Callahan Drive (~25 spaces)

The fee would apply to the reserved short-term parking spaces under item 2. Currently, users must obtain a free permit from the City's website. This proposal would charge \$5 per permit.

Free Motorcoach parking will still be available to bus operators on a first-come, first-served basis on Swann Avenue. Additionally, longer-term parking is also available at the George Washington Masonic Temple.

FISCAL IMPACT: Establishing the on-street reserved Motorcoach parking fee is projected to generate approximately \$6,000 in additional General Fund revenue each year.
