<u>ISSUE</u>: Consideration of an ordinance to amend and reordain Section 3-2-102 (LEVY AND RATE) of Article I (TAX ON SALE OF CIGARETTES) of Chapter 2 (TAXATION) of Title 3 (FINANCE, TAXATION AND PROCUREMENT) of the Code of the City of Alexandria, Virginia, 1981, as amended.

<u>RECOMMENDATION</u>: That City Council pass the proposed ordinance (Attachment I) following the public hearing and second reading on Saturday, May 17, 2014.

DISCUSSION: As part of the City's FY 2015 budget development process, City Council increased the

cigarette tax rate from \$1.00 to \$1.15 per pack to generate additional revenue to support City services. The increase will become effective July 1, 2014.

FISCAL IMPACT: The additional \$0.15 increase per pack is estimated to produce an additional \$210,000 in revenues for FY 2015.
