### Uncontested Appointments to Boards, Commissions, and Committees:

- (a) Board of Architectural Review - Old and Historic District  
2 Citizen Members
- (b) Board of Architectural Review - Parker-Gray District  
2 Citizen Members  
1 Architect Member
- (c) Citizen Corps Council  
1 Member in good standing of the CERT Program
- (d) Commission for the Arts  
1 Member who is a Professional in the field related to the visual appearance of the cityscape, such as architecture, environmental design, landscape architecture or urban design
- (e) Community Policy Management Team  
1 Representative of a private organization or association of providers of children's or family services which provides such services within the City on a continuing and consistent basis
- (f) Environmental Policy Commission  
1 Member from the field of environmental sciences (e.g. environmental/sanitary engineering, ecology, geology, botany, hydrology, chemistry) or who have Alexandria waterfront expertise, provided that at least four members shall have scientific expertise
- (g) George Washington Birthday Celebration Committee  
1 Member nominated by the City of Alexandria Chapter of the Daughters of the American Revolution  
1 Member who attends high school in the City of Alexandria
- (h) Landlord-Tenant Relations Board  
1 Landlord or Representative of a Landlord
- (i) Potomac Yard Design Advisory Committee  
1 Qualified Professional Skilled in Architecture
- (j) Real Estate Assessments Review Board  
1 Citizen Member
- (k) Redevelopment and Housing Authority  
1 Citizen Member

- (l) Visit Alexandria Board of Governors
  - 1 Attraction Representative
  - 3 Representatives from one of the following sectors: Hotel, Retail, Restaurants, or Associations
  - 1 Hotel Owner/Manager
  - 1 Historic/Preservation Representative
  - 1 Retail Owner/Manager
