Introduction and First Reading. Consideration. Passage on First Reading of an Ordinance to amend and reordain Article II to define co-living dwelling and amend apartment hotel and tourist home definitions; Article III to allow co-living dwellings with a Special Use Permit in RM, RB, RS, RT, RMF zones; Article III to allow co-living dwellings with an administrative Special Use Permit in RCX, RA, RC, RD zones; Article IV to allow co-living dwellings with an administrative Special Use Permit in CC, CSL, CG, CD, CD-X, CL, OC, OCH, OCM(50), OCM(100), NR; Article V to allow co-living dwellings with an administrative Special Use Permit in CRMU-L, CRMU-M, CRMU-H, CRMU-X, W-1, zones; Article VI to allow co-living dwellings with an administrative Special Use Permit in KR zone; each zone listed above to classify the use as non-residential for the purpose of applying area and bulk regulations for up to two co-living dwellings; Article VIII to establish parking requirements for co-living dwellings; and Article XI to establish administrative review criteria including number of units, maximum occupancy, sign requirements, and the minimum term for lease agreements as well as identify conditions which require a Special Use Permit in the aforementioned zones, of the City of Alexandria Zoning Ordinance, in accordance with the text amendment heretofore approved by city council as Text Amendment No. 2021-00004 (Implementation Ordinance for Text Amendment No. 2021-00004 associated with Co-Living Dwelling approved by City Council on January 22, 2022).
